Revised Rules for Summer Semester 2025

The competent author is pleased to approve following revised rules for the Summer Semester 2025 for the Main Campus, Sub-Campuses, and Affiliated Colleges Government College University, Faisalabad.

Proposed Amendments to Rule No. 9 (Applicable for Summer Semester 2025 Only)

- 9.1 Students may enroll in the Summer Semester Audit, Deficiency, Failed or improvement a "D" or lowest grade courses.
- 9.2 For BS Bridging programs the teacher must complete at least 48 contact hours for a 3-credit hour course and 64 contact hours for a 4-credit hour course (for deficiency courses only).
- 9.3 The students will be allowed for the enrollment of maximum of two courses regardless of CGPA.
- 9.4 The students who have completed all the degree requirements but attained a CGPA less than 2.00 (after BS 8th, 10th & BS Bridging 8th semester) or less than 2.50 (after MPhil 2nd semester) or less than 3.00 (PhD 2nd semester) may improve up to two courses having "D" or lowest grades.
- 9.5 A course may be offered for a minimum of one student in the case of final semester or expected dropout students. In all other cases, a minimum of three students is required. Students categorized as expected dropouts or whose sessions are complete but have failed more than two courses may be allowed to enroll in a maximum of four courses.
- 9.6 A fee of Rs. 7,000/- per course per student shall be charged (Rs.500/- as late fee) .
- 9.7 A teacher may teach up to three courses in the summer semester. For BS Bridging deficiency courses, remuneration will be paid according to university rules after verification by the Head of the concerned department. For regular summer courses, the teacher will receive 40% of the fee paid per student, up to maximum of Rs. 40,000/-. For online classes, attendance screenshots verified by the concerned Head are required for remuneration.
- 9.8 Paper setting and marking will be paid according to university policy (limited to three courses).
- 9.9 The final decision on students' dropout status will be made after the conclusion of the summer semester.
- 9.10 Students are advised to clear failed subjects from the 2024–2025 academic year during Summer 2025 or as early as possible in subsequent summer semesters.

Affiliated Colleges - Special Instructions

Students from Affiliated Colleges may be allowed to enroll in the Summer Semester 2025 at their respective institutions, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The complete list of enrolled students, with full course details, must be submitted to the Directorate of Academics, GCUF Main Campus within 15 days after the closing of summer semesterregistration.
- 2. A 30% share of the fee (Rs. 2100/-) per student per course shall be deposited with the University at the time of registration.

3. No registration will be entertained after the closing date of registration.
