BS Geography and BS Remote Sensing & GIS	40	40	Required Qualification: Applicants must have passed F.Sc., ICS, F.A. or an equivalent qualification. Minimum Academic Standing: A minimum of 45% marks is required.
BS Bridging Geography	40	40	Required Qualification: Candidates must hold a 2-year Associate Degree (ADA, ADS, ADC) or a traditional 2-year BA / BSc / BCom degree from an HEC-recognized institution. Minimum Academic Standing: At least 45% marks (Annual System) or equivalent CGPA (Semester System).
MPhil Geography and M.Phil. Geography (GIS)	20	20	Eligibility Requirements: Must hold a BS 4-year degree (minimum 130 credit hours) or an equivalent qualification in a relevant field from an HEC-recognized institution. Minimum academic standing: Minimum academic standing: 50% marks under the Annual System OR a 2.50 CGPA under the Semester System. Admission Test: Minimum 50% score required in the departmental entry test. Interview: Mandatory for all test qualified candidates.
PhD Geography	05	05	Minimum academic standing: 3.00 out of 4.00 CGPA (Semester System) OR 1st Division (Annual System) in MS / MPhil Geography and MS/ MPhil GIS or Equivalent Testing Requirements: Must pass the University admission test with a 70% qualifying score , OR score at least 50% on the HAT / GAT / GRE / equivalent test. <i>Note: The respective department will organize the written test and conduct the interviews.</i>
